Virginia Advanced Shipbuilding and Carrier Integration Center

N.N.S. began construction of VASCIC in March of this year on downtown waterfront property. The Virginia General Assembly has approved \$98 million towards construction and start-up of the 230,000 sq. ft. facility, which will be occupied by more than 400 people from the shipyard, U.S. Navy, Virginia shipbuilding industry, Virginia universities and other high-tech companies. Operations will begin in mid-2001.

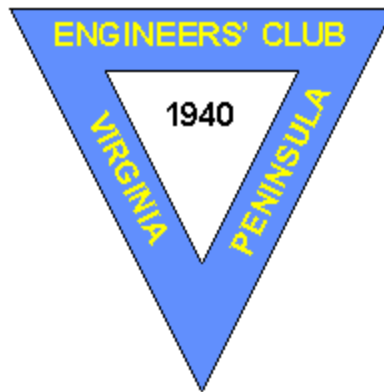
