



Needs ends finished off



Magic scarf:

Fun fur or eyelash type of yarn, two to three skeins needed.

Yellow kk loom or other of this size.

Needle for last row take off.

Cut a long string of yarn to leave for finishing off, four to five feet is what most use. Set aside.

Wrap pegs twice with one strand of yarn.

Pull one stitch over one stitch, wrap one time again. Continue till skein is used, attach next skein and continue in the one over one stitch pattern. If you want scarf longer then use a third skein of yarn.

When finished with all wrapping work till only one stitch is on the pegs. Load needle with the long string you set aside at the beginning.

Leaving a long tail put needle with string through six stitches on the loom, do not pull stitches off till string is through all six. Remove five stitches from pegs (leaving them on the pegs prevents them from binding up for the final step). Put needle through five more stitches, then remove till one strung stitch is left, continue till all stitches have been picked up and removed from loom.

Next step: important: Keep hold of the two ends of the string you used to work off those final stitches.

Places hands inside the circle of the scarf and pull outwards taking up some of the slack from the long string that is holding your stitches. When the opening is as big as you can get it, tie off the two ends together and hide all strings.

Magic scarf done.
