Your grade will be determined by the points you have earned from:

- a) Tests
- b) Quizzes and “Turnins”.
- c) Homework Bonus (1% or 3%)
- d) Homework (Loss of points when not completed)

Tests and quizzes are self explanatory. “Turnins” are problems you copy over from you homework, and turn in. You cannot use your book, only your homework. Thus, be organized! Always put the page and problem numbers on each assignment. This is an easy way to pick up points...if you are neat and well organized.

**A bonus of 1%** of the total points possible during a grading period is given when all assignments are eventually completed. Those late assignments can help you!!!

**A bonus of 3%** is given if every assignment is completed daily *on time*. Excused absences are allowed reasonable time to make up missed assignments.

## **BEWARE!**

Five points will be deducted for each assignment not completed or attempted.

Correct and keep all assignments in a neat location... **Not your textbook!!** A binder is recommended.

The school’s tardy policy will be strictly enforced. 10 unexcused absences *may* lower your grade.

Test missed because of an excused absence, **must be made up within two weeks**. After two weeks the grade will stand as a zero. In short, make up missed tests ASAP!!

Tests missed because of a cut cannot be made up and will result in a zero. If you must cut (Please reconsider), avoid a test day!

Proper class conduct is expected at all times. Cheating will be dealt with through parents and administrators.

I expect all students to take the AP test in May. If you think that the college of your choice will not honor your AP score, talk to me.

The Final will be taken by everyone. Be wise and study for the final for it can help you (or it can hurt you). Good luck and may you have a good year.
