2. Info Sharing with Leaders/Parents We will continue to provide a monthly newsletter. Steve Adams will be updating the Pack web site regularly, so please visit if/when you have any questions that might have answers available on line. Den leaders are encouraged to provide their schedule and any info they would like available to the boys and parents in their den as well. If you have a den newsletter we can post that for you as well. You can forward the material you would like to appear on the web site by e-mail to Steve at steve@pack28.com.
3. We used den parent groups as the Activity Groups for the planned pack events. This worked extremely well, so we will again use that model this year.
4. Register all active parents as adult leaders
 - A) 2 - Registered Adult Leaders at each Den Meeting per BSA policy. If there is a situation when two registered leaders cannot be present, one registered leader and one other adult over 18 is **REQUIRED**. In a situation where there are not at least 2 adults present, the meeting must be postponed until two adults are there or the meeting must be canceled.
 - B) All parents are encouraged (required for Tiger parents) to attend the den meetings. Parents' involvement is not only a great example to the boys, but they (parents) will also be able to answer questions and know what is going on with very little additional effort above this den meeting involvement effort.
5. Costs involved with den activities. If possible, share your plan with other den parents and invite their involvement in obtaining needed items. When that is not practical, keep

receipts and turn in to Mr. Adams for reimbursement. We want to keep it simple, but our budget is somewhat limited, so when parents can help directly we appreciate it. Den Leaders are NOT expected to buy/donate the needed items themselves!

6. Cost for registration and pack finance. New registrations will be \$45.00 this year, renewals will be \$30.00.
7. Camp registration / outdoor event coordination. Steve Adams is the Camp Contact/Coordinator. This year we need to have resident camp registrations in by March for the Camp Dates we want. Our Pack has Gold Card this year! So we need to have everything in (to Council) by April 15th! Day Camp registrations at May Pack Meeting, with final cut-off for early registration on July 15th.

Other events could be covered as well, i.e. Chili Cook-off, Camporees, Klondike, and District and Council sponsored Fun Days and events as they become available.

The First Pack Leaders Meeting, preliminary agenda (to be updated as necessary):

1. Review the Pack program plan for the year.
2. Suggest that Den schedules are established and receive back from each den.
3. Have their at least 1 meeting (2 if possible) before the September Pack Meeting
