

HEALTH SERVICES

The school nurse has a regularly scheduled time at school. She is on call at all times for emergencies. A qualified health aide is on campus everyday. Feel free to call if you have any health related concerns.

Emergency first aid is given for accidents that occur at school. Parents will be notified of those accidents that require follow-up care. **All parents should be sure that an up-to-date Emergency Card is on file at the school** in order that proper attention can be promptly given in case of all accidents. **It is most important that someone may be reached at home or at work.**

MEDICATION POLICY

The California Education Code provides for school personnel to supervise children in taking necessary, physician prescribed medication at school. Medication must be brought to school **by an adult in a properly labeled pharmacy container**. A permission form is to be completed by the parent and a physician's Data Form completed by the prescribing physician.

Over the counter medication such as Benadryl, Tylenol, and cough drops may be administered at school provided that the **parent and physician complete the necessary forms**. All medication is kept in a locked cupboard in the nurse's office for the protection of all our students.
