CHAPTER 13: TABLES

1. Be able to write the tags for a basic 2x3 table.
2. How do you add a solid black border with pixel size 2 to the table above?
3. How do you center the contents of all cells?
4. How do you make the table fill 100% of the screen width?
5. How do you specify the font Tempus Sans ITC with backup as fantasy for the table with font color blue?
6. How do you change the background color of a table to orange?
7. How do you prevent an empty cell in a table from collapsing or losing its color?
8. How do you specify that the spacing between borders is 2px horizontally and 4 px vertically?
9. How do you specify that the padding within each cell is 20 px?

CHAPTER 14: FRAMES

1. List 2 main advantages and 3 main disadvantages of using frames.
2. How do you prevent a frame from being resized?
3. Write the frame tags to create a framed document with two columns, 20% and 80% of the screen. The column on the left hand side should contain toc.html (a table of contents) so that when a link is clicked, it is displayed in the column on the right. The right column should initially be filled with a file called main.html. The table of contents should have a link to main.html and a link to other.html. Also show what the contents of the **body** of toc.html should be.

CHAPTER 15: FORMS

1. Write the tags to put a button named myButton labeled with "Don't click this" which triggers an alert box saying "I said not to click!".
2. Write the tags to run a PHP script at <http://home.lagrange.edu/riddle/myphp.php> when the user of the form clicks submit. The user should be prompted to type his/her name into a textbox called myName, and the form should have both a submit and a reset button.
3. Create a set of radio buttons called candy with labels "Baby Ruth", "Starburst", "Jolly Rancher", "Dove Promises" and with "Dove Promises: checked by default.
4. Create a multiline text box named "blob" with 5 rows and 25 columns.
