

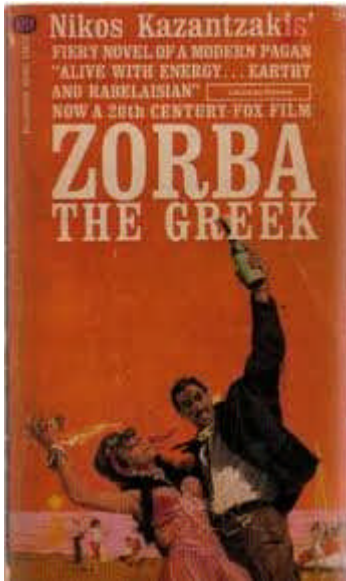
**THROOP BOOK GROUP** – September – November 2011

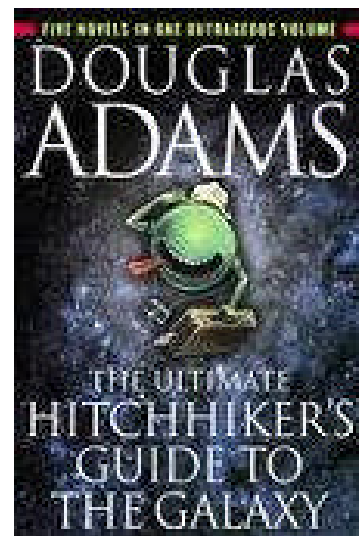
*Zorba the Greek* by Nikos Kazantzakis
