Dear AP English Literature and Composition Student,

To fully realize your reading experience of AP level material and to further prepare for technology use on the college level, you will engage in the use of Blackboard to keep a running discussion of the novel you are reading during the summer. This is **required**, and you will receive a grade for you entries as well as for your **QQT** assignments.

During the period from **June 15 to July 13** you are to engage in discussion of the first novel *The Stranger* by Camus. You must have **two** entries or responses, more if you wish. During the reading period from **July 14 to August 14** you must respond on Blackboard **twice** for the reading of *Jane Eyre* by Brontë. I will often interject a comment as well; however, you are to initiate the exchange. Need I say that appropriate language and comments are expected?

Also check for "Announcements" for any important information.

One last note, I do subtract 10 points for each day any assignment that is late.

I do hope that you enjoy reading the novels. I have chosen them carefully to reflect the level of reading for which you should be challenged as well as those which appear frequently on the AP Literature and Composition Exam, free-response item.

If you have not already given me your contact information, you must do so. I can then send your id and password.
