4. **Pictures** – Scheduled with Picture Pro Photography for Tuesday, May 29th and Wednesday, May 30th. Like last year, they will be taken across from the Community Center where there is better parking.

5. **Little League Night at Miller Park** – This will be Monday, June 18th at 7:05 p.m. vs. the Giants. Heidi will organize again this year. Bus fee will increase to \$10/person. We forgot to discuss whether or not to schedule games that night – last year everyone had the night off, which made for pretty good participation in this event.

6. **Donation of Land** – Jeff Tavs attended the most recent Recreation Board meeting to see about the possibility of obtaining 5 acres of land from the city to be used for new little league diamonds. They will be getting back to us on the issue. The land would be adjacent to the land which the school district said we could potentially use for some new diamonds, though now it looks as if that land may be strictly used for high school diamonds. Either way, we decided we need to wait to hear on these items before putting any more money into our current fields (batting cage area, i.e.).

7. **Other Items** – Clean Up Day will be Saturday, April 21st 9-noon. We need to go through the old jerseys (we hope to send them to a company in Pennsylvania who collects them and distributes them to other areas of the world or country who needs them) and box them. We also need to put the new grill together – bring tools.

We hope to have an apparel order form available at registration this year – Heidi is working with Dawn Disch at 2-D Design on this. It would also be nice to have t-shirts available at tournaments.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:20 p.m. The next meeting, and last one before our season starts, will probably be sometime the last week of March, before the draft on April 2nd.
