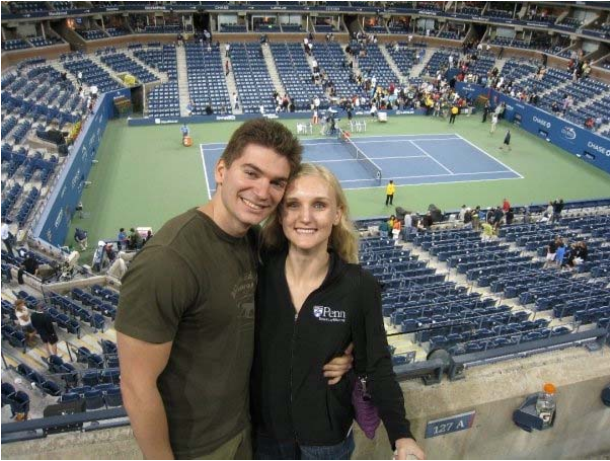


Happy Holidays 2009
