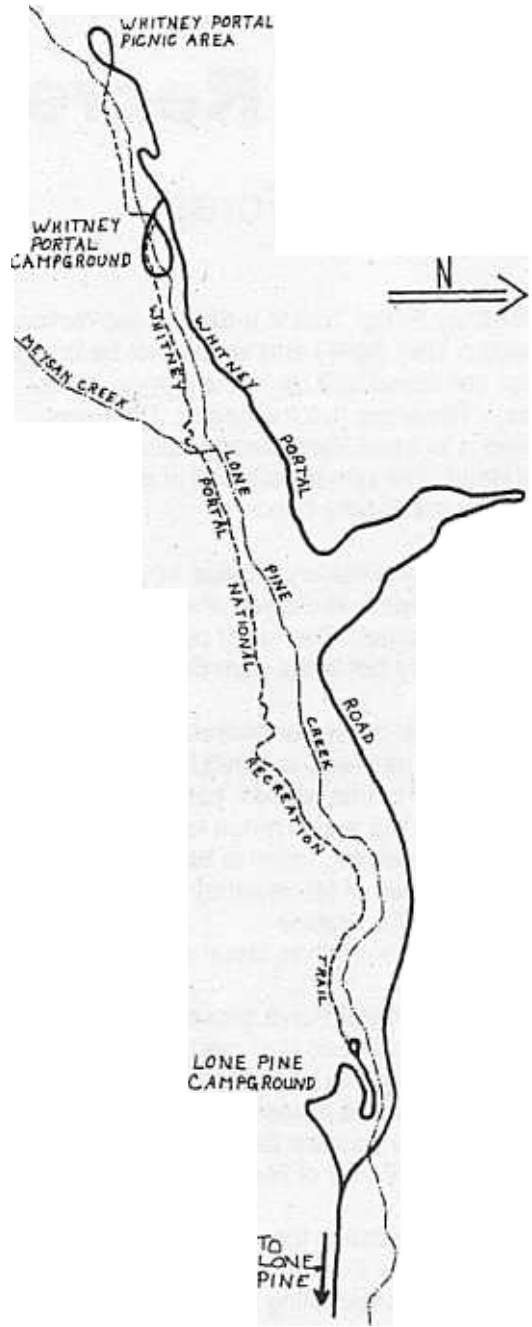


In 1979, the lower portion was reworked, once again and rerouted where necessary. Now it provides a sometimes demanding but choice route for day hikers, one which many old timers feel offers beauty unmatched by the upper trail.

REGULATIONS:

1. Camping is not allowed along this trail so if you wish to stay overnight plan your hike to camp either at Lone Pine Campground or one of the campgrounds at Whitney Portal.
2. Wheeled vehicles are not allowed on the trail - foot traffic only!
3. Livestock is not allowed on this trail.
4. Fires are not permitted.
5. Please carry out all your trash.
