### 4th of July Arts & Crafts Fair Guidelines 10 am to 5 pm

- The Arts and Craft Fair is held in Scott Park, on Main St. (Hwy. 21), Omro, WI
- Make checks payable to the Omro Lions Club and mail to above address.
- Please include a SASE.
- \$40.00 entry fee for a ten by ten foot space. Additional consecutive spaces are available for \$40.
- Registrations postmarked after June 10 will be \$50 per space.
- There will be no refunds after June 10.
- Enclose an S-240 vendor sheet.
- Each exhibitor must provide their own tables and chairs.
- ONLY HANDCRAFTED ITEMS PRODUCED BY THE EXHIBITOR WILL BE ALLOWED.
- Commercially made items will NOT be allowed.
- Set up time begins at 6:00 am.
- Spaces are awarded on a first come first serve basis.
- At Noon there will be a large parade that passes in front of the Arts & Craft Fair.
- At mid-afternoon a duck race is held in the park lagoon.
- Many visitors remain into the evening for the large fireworks display.
- Attendance is close to 18,000 visitors for the day.
- Every effort will be made to make your attendance an enjoyable experience.
- Driving on the park grass to unload is allowed if feasible.
- After unloading in the park and before setting up, your vehicle MUST be removed from the park immediately.
- There is no vehicle, automobile, trailer, truck, van or SUV parking on the grass.

- Handicap parking is available on the West side of the park next to the library.
- Food and refreshments will be available in Scott Park throughout the day. The Lion's are serving Taco in a Bag. Haven't tried it? You'll love it. Also, Fox Valley Cheese House a few blocks down the street will be serving sandwiches. Hardee's closed Jan. 08 but Kwik Trip and Main Street Restaurant are a few blocks away.
