Volunteer Opportunity Descriptions

Wreath Sale – Oct. through Dec.

The wreath sale is the main fundraiser for Pack 26. Beth Wolfset co-ordinates the fund drive which kicks off during the October Pack Meeting. A couple of volunteers are needed help with logistical planning, to help coordinate and assign routes and manage the awards/prizes that are associated with the wreath sale.

Craft Night – December Pack Meeting

This year we will be holding a craft night during the December pack meeting. We need volunteers to help plan this meeting. Specifically, the committee will need to identify the crafts to be made by the scouts, coordinate the procurement of materials etc. to build the crafts and to man craft stations during the meeting.

Pinewood Derby – Cars distributed during December meeting – Race Day – January 31

Several volunteers are needed to help with the Pinewood Derby. We need a volunteer to co-ordinate this year's race. Additional committee members are needed to fill the following positions: registration/weigh in, repair station, set up crew, clean up crew, race official, refreshments

Blue and Gold Banquet – Feb/Mar

Historically, the parents of the graduating Webelos are responsible for planning and managing the Blue and Gold Banquet. A meeting will be called shortly for all parents of these Webelos to form a committee for this major event. Tasks include finding and booking a place for the dinner, deciding upon a theme for the evening, finding guest speakers, coordinating a pot-luck or similar type of dinner, decorations, clean up etc.

Valentines Day Luncheon – February 7

Every year Pack 26 invites Southborough seniors to join us for a Valentine's Day Luncheon. We serve a simple lunch consisting of sandwiches (cold cuts), chips, beverages, and an array of assorted deserts. Cub Scouts act as waiters. They take orders from seniors and serve the lunches. Parents make sandwiches and prepare the individual orders. A competitive game of bingo follows. We need a volunteer to co-ordinate this event. Additional committee members are needed to purchase food, make arrangements for families to bring cookies/brownies etc. and to participate in the event. This is a fun time and the seniors really enjoy talking with the Cub Scouts.

Service Projects Coordinator – On Going

We are looking for a volunteer to take responsibility for managing Pack 26 service projects throughout the year. Current service projects include Gift Baskets for Southborough seniors, Valentines Day luncheon, Earth Day clean up and the food pantry collection.
