Women are traditionally not allowed in this room. However, in our diwaniya, Arab women are free to discuss their hopes, desires, problems, and struggles without shame or fear. In the privacy of their own home, viewers of “Diwaniya” hear Christian experts discuss topics that include marriage relationships, divorce, virginity, rape, incest, homosexuality, domestic abuse and violence. These are subjects that have never been openly discussed in Arab culture.
