Mission And Goals

Social Goals: a) To plan periodic social activities in conjunction with our monthly meetings.  
b) To meet periodically with the parish women's organization to plan and develop parish - wide and family social functions ( at least 2 each year).  
c) To encourage parish - centered card parties, breakfasts, dinners, and other events or functions that would promote fraternity and closer Christian relationships and communications.

Fund - Raising Goals: a) To promote a charitable responses to evident and requested need in our church - family and Christian community through discreet and responsible use of designated treasury funds by our organization's elected officials.  
b) To continue the tradition of the annual Chicken Q and broaden its appeal and participation to include all parishioners, neighboring parishes and friends in the community.
